



2019 CERA Dual Sport Challenge

Saturday, June 8 – River Ranch Campground, Tuolumne, CA

The Challenge

Test your riding and navigation skills along 100 miles of scenic national forest trails. Take selfies along the route at Challenge waypoints and compete for great prizes. Lunch will be provided.

Saturday Night

Wrap up your day with Challenge awards and prizes, and a terrific BBQ dinner (optional) and campfire. Liquid refreshments will be available.

The Site

River Ranch Campground in Stanislaus National Forest features remote camping on the river and hot showers – what more could you want? A casino, perhaps? Black Oak Casino is down the road and has fuel, a market, and hotel accommodation.

Registration

Registration opens March 1, 2019. \$75 covers Friday night camping, lunch on Saturday, your choice of three pre-ridden dual sport and adventure bike routes, and Challenge Entry. Optional: BBQ dinner Saturday night (\$15); stay over another night and enjoy riding on Sunday (included).



The Fine Print – IMPORTANT!

Registration opens March 1 – 75 Rider limit! Street-legal, plated bikes only. Event runs rain or shine. Snow or forest fire postpones, with reschedule in Fall, 2019. No Refunds!
Event check-in opens at 5pm on Friday, June 7 at River Ranch Campground. GPS tracks and turn-by-turn route sheet will be provided onsite. Mandatory rider/safety meetings will be held at 7pm on Friday evening, and 8am on Saturday morning at the Campground Headquarters. All Challenge participants must attend one of these two rider meetings and sign the waiver. No waiver, no ride – NO EXCEPTIONS!
