- Read, sign and date entry form. If under 18 years of age, parent, legal guardian or an adult who presents a notarized authorization to sign on behalf of the parent must countersign the entry and be present at sign-up.
- Enclose copies of District 36 card, AMA Card, and Club Card if you are in an Enduro sponsoring Club. AMA and D36 cards will be available at signups

GENERAL INFORMATION

- AMA and District 36 rules apply. First rider out at 08:01 AM
- National Restart Enduro format. No early check penalties - no computer required
- 250 rider limit. 2 Riders per minute pre-entry, 2-3 riders per minute post entry.
- The course will be approximately 70 miles with gas back at your vehicle
- USFS approved muffler and spark arrestor required.
- California off road sound regulations enforced
- Off-Road registration or License Plate required.
- Camping available at Elkins Flat. Campfire permits required if restrictions not in place. Please check with USFS before arrival.
- Route sheets (No Jarts) and T-Shirts available at the event
- 35-40 mile gas range required. Gas will be at your vehicle at staging
- No pit riding. Pre-riding in the area on Friday Oct. 25th = DQ!
- Parent or legal guardian must sign for riders under 18.
- This is NOT a closed course event. All trails and roads used during the event are subject to two way traffic. There will be strictly enforced 20 MPH road sections in the transfer sections due potential 2 way traffic. Speeding = DQ! Hunting season - vehicles on roads.
- Spectators witnessing these events assume all risks for any injuries or damages resulting there from. NO RIDER INSURANCE.
- Sign-ups will be open Friday before the event from 6-8 PM. Signups re- open Saturday at 6:00 AM

- Family enduro will start immediately after so late entries will be limited

49er Enduro – Saturday October 26th, 2019

GENERAL:

Key Time is 8:00 AM

- **The Forest Service may be doing motorcycle inspections for "Noxious Weeds".**
- All riders must check in to pickup their fender score card and helmet sticker. Riding numbers with letter must be displayed on your front number plate.
- All loops start and end at the staging area. Please use care refueling at your vehicle.
- **DO NOT START MOTORCYCLE ENGINES AFTER 8:00pm Friday NIGHT OR BEFORE 6:00am ON Saturday MORNING.**
- All participants must check in at Sign-In.
- Sign-In will be open on Friday from 6:00pm until 9:00pm. It will open on Saturday morning starting at 6:00am.
- **PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A GUARDIAN PRESENT AT SIGN-IN TO SIGN A RELEASE FORM. IF THE GUARDIAN IS NOT THE PARENT OF THE PARTICIPANT, THERE MUST BE A NOTARIZED LETTER FROM THE PARENT RECOGNIZING THE INDIVIDUAL AS THE GUARDIAN.**
- **NO RIDER MEDICAL INSURANCE WILL BE PROVIDED.**
- License plates or off-road registration and mufflers with spark arrestors are required and may be inspected by United States Forest Service. Sound tests will be given Saturday morning. Bikes that do not meet California off road sound requirements will not be permitted to participate in the event.
- **Strict 20 MPH speed limit on all roads in the transfer sections.** Speeders will be disqualified. This is for you and other riders safely.
- All paved roads in the Elkins area are STREET LEGAL only. They are not used on the course. If you ride on them, you are subject to being ticketed. Law enforcement will be in the area. The Forest Service has received complaints from local property owners.

SCORING/ETIQUETTE/COURSE:

- AMA and District 36 rules apply. AMA National "Restart" rules will be used
- **YOU MUST TURN YOUR SCORE CARD IN, FINISH OR NOT.**
- **Slower riders move over as soon as it is safe and let the faster rider's past.**
- **Faster riders use caution and pass with care.**
- * All roads and trails used in this course are subject to travel by non-contestant vehicles. Extreme caution must be used by everyone. Watch for flagmen and signs indicating intersections. Remote locations have road crossings without guards, use extra caution.
- * Stay on the marked course at all times. If you break down, stay with your bike on the course. The entire course will be swept afterwards. The sweepers will see to it that you will get back to camp.
- * Course is approximately **TBA** ground miles.
- * Gas is at your vehicle after each loop 1. Allow time to get to the next restart after the free time as it is "gas available".
- * There are several dangerous areas off course from previous heavy rains. If you are off course turn around and get back on course. Several people have been injured falling into these areas over the summer.
- * There may be direction splits in the transfer sections for the family enduro riders. Please read and heed all course markings.

CAMPING/PARKING:

- * USFS Travel Management policies include new parking restrictions, which will be strictly enforced. Parking is allowed in designated areas only. We will do all we can to help you comply with these regulations, which may include asking you to move your vehicle.
- * Free primitive camping is available throughout area near sign-ups. Please obey posted Forest Service camping/parking guidelines.
- * Camp fires may be controlled by Forest Service. Please obey posted signs. **Bring a shovel and make sure if you have a fire its out when you leave your camp.**
- * Please pick up your trash and take it home. We would like to thank each and everyone that attended our past events for your excellent cooperation in keeping the area clean and following the rules of the forest.

WHAT IS A RESTART ENDURO?

- No "secret checks" will be used. You will restart on your assigned minute when you reach restart checkpoint: white and yellow flags with an "ST" printed on them. You may arrive early and wait for your minute to enter the timed section just like the beginning of the race
- At the end of a "timed" section there will be an "Emergency" check, white and green flags with an "E" on them. You will not reach these checkpoints "early" unless you cut the course.
- You must stop and be scored at every checkpoint. If you do not stop and get scored you will be scored as out at the previous checkpoint
- You **cannot** start early at a restart checkpoint. If you do you will be penalized per normal enduro scoring rules.
- If you are late to a restart check you are scored late and incur a penalty. There is time built in to the course, so you do not have to speed to the next restart check after the emergency check. Maintain an easy pace between timed sections and you will not have a problem. **There is a mandatory 20 MPH speed limit on all roads in the transfer sections due to likelihood of two-way traffic.**
- If you are late to a check you DO NOT assume a new minute as in some "Q" format enduros. The same minute is used throughout the entire event. You restart with your row at each restart

FAMILY ENDURO

- The Family Enduro course and loops still TBA.
